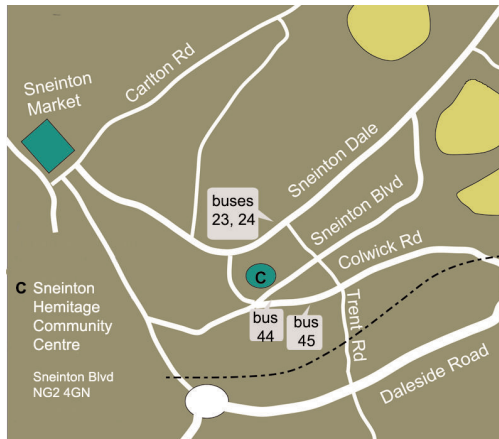

How to find us

Sneinton Hermitage Community Centre is on Sneinton Boulevard.

The closest bus, number 44 (from outside Argos at the city centre) stops at Colwick Road after the traffic lights where Colwick Road and Sneinton Boulevard join. You will see a sign for the cafe outside the community centre. Buses 23 & 24 stop a few minutes walk away.

The 45 comes via Mapperly & so takes a long time, unless you are coming from Mapperly.
