We can arrange transport but will make a small charge of £1 toward the cost.

Evaluation Forms

Thank you for filling in the evaluation forms. We had 18 returned and have spent some time looking at them. They will certainly help shape any future funding bids.

In terms of location and transport we think we are on the right path.

More people would rather attend the project if it was in town. More than half of people who responded said they were happy to use either public transport or a car to get to the project.

We think this will be even easier if we can keep to a central location.

Some people did say they would need transport provided and we hope to be able to continue to do this.
